

FORKLIFT DRIVER

Job Summary: A successful Nora Forklift Driver will be responsible for the proficient and safe use f a forklift. The Forklift Driver is required to have the necessary training and current permit to operate a forklift. The Driver will operate an electric industrial forklift to move materials to and from their designated areas. Nora Lighting Forklift drivers have many functions and responsibilities. RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

The Forklift Driver will safely operate a forklift to:

- Move Materials to and from designated locations.
- refill empty rack locations with reserve stock.
- Load and unload containers.
- Stage orders or materials to facilitate their location.
- Help Pullers, Production, QC, RGA, Cycle Counters and any dept move pallets and locate materials.
- Drivers must perform a visual quality check on all inbound and outbound materials.
- Forklift Drivers must complete a weekly inspection of their forklift, fill out checklist and notify the Supervisor or Manager of any issues or safety hazards.
- Must keep the warehouse clean and organized at all times.
- Drivers are held accountable for physical movements of materials to accurately reflect transactions in database.
- Forklift drivers must notify the proper departments of any damages or shortages.
- Always follow all safety rules and regulations.
- Any other tasks or projects may be assigned by Supervisor or Manager.

- Ability to lift up to 75 lbs
- Ability to squat, sit, stand, walk, reach consistently and daily as needed to perform all job functions
