Question: Are the New Ari Step Lights dimmable?

Answer: No! just the New Mia and Bricks.

Question: Ari is offered in 3000K and 4000K, is this common?

Answer: No! Our competitors usually only offer one or the other! 3000K is good for architectural features and 4000K is better if the step light is illuminating plants.

Question: Where do I mount step lights?

Answer: Well the obvious answer is in the face of the step (riser) for safety and notification of elevation change. They can also be mounted on a wall to illuminate a step or path of light. The mounting height off the floor will vary from 6" to 18". The distance between each will vary as well. Well-lit stairs or entries are safer and inviting to your guest, in commercial and residential applications.

Question: Why use an Ari with the open scoop vs the Mia with a louver or hood?

Answer: Ari's style is better at projecting the light out further, whereas the louver and hood units project more of the light downward. The louver and hood units will not be as bright at the source, while the scoops produce more light; they are also a little brighter at the source.

Question: Do step lights always have to illuminate a step?

Answer: No, step lights can be used in hallways as night light, outdoors they can be used to illuminate a path, or in outdoor cooking areas.
